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FEES PAYABLE TO THE REGISTRAR FOR COMPLEMENTARY MEDICINES

It is the intention of the Minister of Health following consultation with the Minister of Finance, Stakeholders and the Medicines Control Council, as per the provisions of Section 35(1) of the Medicines and Related Substances Act, 1965 (Act 101 of 1965) to make regulations on application fees payable to the Registrar of Medicines for the registration of Complementary medicines.

Introduction

The following fees shall be payable to the Registrar of Medicines, for the registration of Complementary medicines. These fees should be read in conjunction with the fees published under Government Notice No. R 918 of 7 November 2012.

Category D medicines

Human and Veterinary medicines, compounded in its entirety in the RSA or not, for which an application for registration has been submitted as contemplated in Section 15 of the Act,

in respect of the submission of an application for registration of-

- (i) Products submitted with clinical and or toxicological data: R12 400 per application;
- (ii) Products with no clinical or toxicology data: R5 500 per application.
